Raised on turned legs riding on the original brass castors, this stand offers three tiers with a rising adjustable notched music reading stand at the top and a useful drawer at the foot dressed with turned pulls. The rosewood grain detail and rich tone is a delight in each of the shelves that rise on turned column supports to a flat height of 122cm (48"), the tilting top benefits from a lower bar to support music sheets or reading material at a good height for a standing position. A fine example of its type with solid joints and construction. Delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
