- 7cm, 2.75", achromatic doublet objective lens
- Rack and pinion, fine focusing wheel
- A pair of eye tubes offering different magnifications and a single tinted filter
- Engraved 'E. Lennie, Edinburgh' to the collar
- Standing upon a robust, table top, tripod of cabriole legs and spade feet
- The fitted pitch pine case in good antique order
- Original retailers card to the inside of the lid
