- Hand built to the highest level of craftsmanship
- In mahogany with excellent colour and finish
- Accentuated with bronzed beading and golden highlights
- Raised on tapering circular section legs with bronze toes
- Double field panelled sides rise to a shaped crown moulding in good proportion
- Rounded front corners fluted and highlighted

• A pair of field panel doors lock top and bottom with original lock, key and slide mechanism

- The glazed panels feature the original blown glass that ripple in the light
- A central bronze dust strip closing the cabinet, a real sign of quality
- Inside four fully adjustable shelves
- Edged with twin bronze string detail
