




Antique Centre Table, English, William IV Breakfast Table, Mahogany Circa 1835

- Raised on trumpet form pillar anchored in beautifully turned collar
- Standing upon a broad, circular platform base
- Three, fan carved, scroll feet ride upon hidden brass castors
