This is a classic antique conservatory suite, a Bergere sofa and chairs dating to the Edwardian period of the early 20th century, circa 1910.

- Beautifully crafted in mahogany with good colour and graining
- Deep seat enclosed with traditional Bergere caning
- Bergere cane in generally good condition throughout - professionally replaced in some sections. We mention, for the sake of accuracy, that one panel to the inner face of an armchair has detached partially, and that there is slight damage to the rear of one armchair also. • Original plum velour upholstery over feather filled cushions - some fading and minor splits

• Traditionally sprung stuff-over seat panels with brocade trim

• Raised on carved, squat cabriole legs to the front
