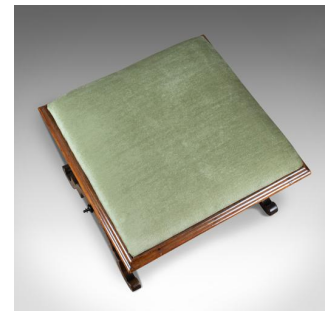


Antique Dressing Stool, Rosewood, Olive Green Cloth, English, Regency, c. 1820
