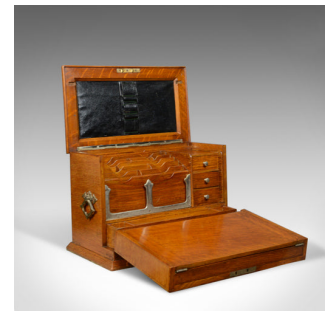
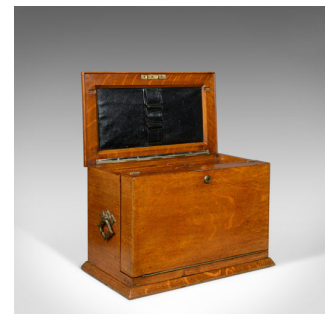


Antique Campaign Writing Box, English, Victorian, Oak, Stationery, 1887

- The fall hinges forwards to expose a comprehensive stationery suite
- Complete with removable pen tray and three drawers dressed with brass pulls
- The fall unfolds into a writing slope with gold tooled skiver
