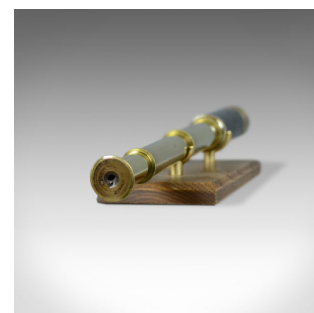


Antique Telescope, Three Draw Refractor, J Casartelli and Son, Circa 1900

- Slight deformation to eyecup perimeter
- An historic, period piece as good to use today as it was a hundred years ago
