- Brass lock escutcheon with reeded drop handle, key present
- Brass rail and hooks provide hanging space
- A pair of cupboard doors with inlaid field frieze sit above a galleried shelf
- A suite of three graduated drawers feature circular reeded drop handles
- Raised upon a continuous plinth base

This is a versatile antique wardrobe with rich mahogany hues. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
