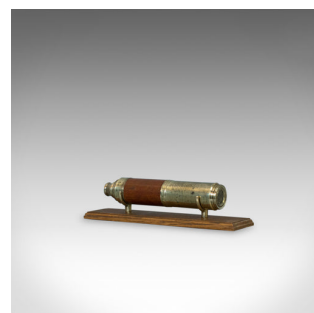
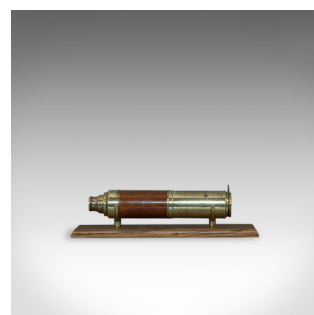


Antique Telescope, 3 Draw, Terrestrial, Astronomical, English, Georgian, C.1780
