Our Stock # LFA-1109 This is an antique set of six William IV Dining Chairs dating to c.1835. In good, original condition this set of chairs are a feast for the eyes; the exquisite flame mahogany shines in the crest rails which terminate in the carved roses and scrolls that harmonise with the mirrored scrolls and central rose detail found in the lower rail united by the fanned stile relief. Beneath the front seat rail attractive reeded legs with a triple ring detail taper to the turned foot. The rear sabre leg flare beautifully providing added stability to the chairs. The upholstery and webbing to the substantial and weighty drop in seats are all in good condition. Five have older velvet coverings with one more recently replaced, although perfectly acceptable, these would be easy to recover in a fabric of your choice. Overall a fabulous set of six chairs in good, original antique condition. Solid joints and construction. Delivered waxed & polished ready for the home.
