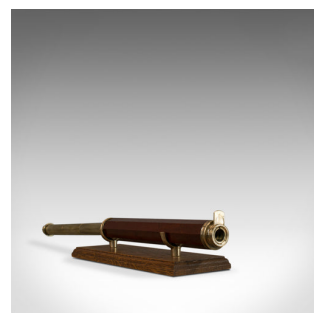
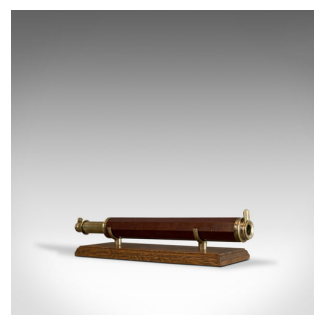


Antique Telescope, English, Single Draw, Refractor, Terrestrial, Circa 1760
