- Case delineated with elegant, boxwood chevron banding
- Decorated with a turned brass finial between a broken arched pediment
- Barometer face encased within a glass door, dressed with brass clasp
- Main barometer runs centrally, with manually adjustable change indicator
- Secondary temperature scale shows Fahrenheit
- Flat trunk runs to a hemispherical cistern cover
