This is an inlaid antique breakfast table. An English, rosewood centre or game table dating to the early Victorian period of the mid-19th century, circa 1850.

- A rare, four-seater table of much visual appeal and fine form
- Displays a desirable aged patina throughout
- Select rosewood with copious grain interest
- Wonderful colour with rich caramel hues
- Central, exotic stone marguetry with mother of pearl, statuary marble and boxwood
- The circumference of the table featuring further inlay of holly with fine delineation
- A deep rolled edge moulding features above the carved apron
- Apron decorated with scrolled detail against a continuous diamond pattern ground
- \bullet A stout, tapering, ring-turned and carved $\,$ barrel column provides stable support
- Graceful, fluted, scrolled knees terminate in up-turned leaf motif
- Standing upon well-executed, large, four-claw, hairy paw feet
