This is an antique room divider. A French, needlepoint screen or photography prop featuring a tapestry of Jean Corot's Dance of the Nymphs and dating to the late 19th century, circa 1880.

- Brass fittings allow it to be folded in all directions to completely flat
- Highly detailed needlepoint depiction of Jean Baptiste Camille Corot's 'Dance of the Nymphs'
 - Rich detail in the foliage and female figures
 - Marked D'apres Corot to the bottom left corner
 - Rear decorated with emerald green fabric marks consistent with age
