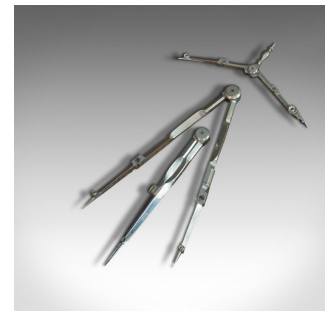


Antique Instrument Set, English, Architect's, Technical Drawing, Davis & Sons
