This is a vintage ship's cabinet. A rare, Asian Coromandel decorative maritime cupboard, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1930.

- Wonderfully rare, hand-crafted cabinet with good provenance

- Deep, dark hues and wisps of bright amber tones shine beneath the wax polish finish
- Tall proportions set the cabinet apart
- Field panel front door carved with patera to centre and panel corners
- Distinctive Greek key decoration to upper fascia
- Dressed with an inset working lock — key present
- Interior arranged as three shelves
- Raised upon four square section legs, with pierced, carved brackets adding a flourish to each side
