- Iron and leather bound for lasting strength
- Dressed with large iron clasps to each side of the front fascia
- Decorative German copper plate to lid edge
- Wide leather carriage straps to each side with shaped iron keepers
- Stout lid opens upon rear hinges with bracket hinge to the right
- The interior finished with a foliate lining of cream and green hues
- The base lined with a map of Launceston District in Cornwall, dating to 1906
