This is an antique locking tantalus. An English, oak and silver plated decanter case by Fenton Brothers of Sheffield, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Alluring tantalus with decorative appeal
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- Oak case shows fine grain interest with striking medullary rays
- Cut glass in very good order throughout
- Two-piece locking bar uniting both sides with sinuous handle to centre
- Circular, working lock secures access to the decanters key present
- Shaped stile ends decorated with silver plated brightwork
- Plinth base with attractive bracing in the Gothic revival taste
- Trio of superb decanters with cut glass decorative finish and eye-catching faceted stoppers
 - Named for the character in Greek mythology, Tantalus
