This is a pair of antique buckle back chairs. An English, walnut dining or side seat, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1840.

- Sinuous top rail with gently chamfered edges resides over a delightfully pinched waist

 - Superb, turned octagonal baluster knees dare to fascinate
 - Raised upon a pair of tall peg feet to the front
 - Gently splayed rear legs with square section toe
