This is an antique revolving table-top platter. An English, oak octagonal Lazy Susan with ecclesiastical taste, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1884.

- Prominent decorative serving platter with strong ecclesiastic or Masonic taste
- Displaying a desirable aged patina - in very good order
- Select oak shows fine grain interest
- Rich russet hues beam beneath the wax polish finish
- Bold octagonal top carved with appealing details and dressed with polished metal plating to edge
- Circular crest to centre bears the Latin motto 'Ne Quid Nimis' - nothing in excess
- A looped belt motif encircles an eagle stood upon a small shield
- The decorative border with repeating diamond pattern hosts the initials GA and the date of 1884
- Raised and rotating smoothly upon a tapering central column with carved crosshatch fretwork
- Standing upon a deep tapered base with canted corners
