This is a vintage Sarouk rug. A Persian, woollen Dozar sized hall or lounge carpet, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1930.

- A traditional Dozar sized rug at 219cm (86.25") x 130cm (51.25")
- Displaying a desirably aged patina with decades of gentle sun fading and minimal wear
- Wonderfully ornate woven pile with dark blue ground and mellow cream and blush pink hues
 - Comfortable underfoot feel ideal for the entrance hall or lounge
 - Arranged with a central medallion issuing a melange of flowers and foliage
 - Striking shaped corners with foliate motif against a pink and cream background
 - \bullet Trio of tramline borders decorate the edges with flowers and linked patterns
 - Tightly arranged, short tassels to both ends in good order

This is a charming vintage Sarouk rug from the North-west of Persia. Sarouk was a favoured centre for American exports in the early 20th century thanks to their overall foliate taste. This appealing example is delivered ready to be laid.
