


Late Victorian Oak Antique Stick Stand, c.1890



DESCRIPTION

Our Stock # LFA-1356This is an antique, Victorian stick or umbrella stand dating to c.1890.Beautifully made in English oak showing deep russet tones with a desirable aged patina, this stand is raised on turned feet and features a removable tin drip tray for easy emptying.The ring turned legs continue up to box section at the frieze which is beautifully relief carved featuring a reciprocating arched detail with foliate embellishment. To the end panels a central rosette motif stands prominent.The upper section is usefully divided into three sections and cornered by ball finials.A country antique with an enduring purpose and desirability. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
