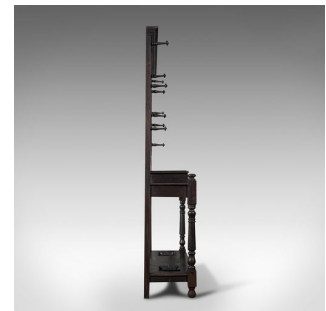


Tall Antique Hall Stand, English, Oak, Mirror, Coat Rack, Chinoiserie, Victorian

This is a tall antique hall stand. An English, oak stand with mirror and coat rack of carved Chinoiserie taste, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1880.

- Distinctive Oriental carvings decorate this versatile stand
- Displays a desirable aged patina and presented in good order
- Select oak with dark stained finish beneath a wax polish coat
- Original mirror plate with desirable light foxing and clear reflection
- Impressive upstand with copious elaboration a visual delight
- Large dragon carvings to the open sides with shapely, defined wings
- Carved foliate borders abound, framing the generously sized mirror to the centre
- Dressed with 10, prominent turned coat and hat rails
- Covered glove box with hinged lid sits over an open middle
- Turned baluster supports with square sections to rear surround a useful stick stand
- Removable drip trays to rear provide drainage for umbrellas
