This is a superb antique chiffonier. A Scottish, oak sideboard cabinet, dating to the mid-Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Revel in the exquisite figuring to this attractive Scottish cabinet
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select Scottish oak offers fine grain interest and an abundance of medullary rays
- Rich caramel hues beam beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Classical pediment sits above the whole, over a useful display shelf on shaped bracket arms
 - Generously sized buffet sideboard at a comfortable height of 92cm (36.25")
 - Arranged as a wide central drawer over a two-door cupboard base
- Cabinet base framed by two carved pilasters, sitting flush with the drawer above when closed
- Drawer dressed with brass drop handles over shaped backplates with male masque and foliate detail
 - Small brass, lock escutcheon to door over a working lock key present
 - Stout shelf to interior well-sized for a dinner service or a drinks collection
