This is an antique hallway stand. An English, mahogany reception cane or umbrella rack, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Each corner dressed with a wooden spherical finial over square shoulders
- Ring turned supports united by stretchers to upper, arranged as a trio of openings

• Full-width, removable cast iron drip tray to base, with good, consistent graphite finish

• Raised upon a quartet of decorated and tapering peg feet

This is a charming antique hallway stand, with deep polished finish and useful for wet umbrellas with its removable drip tray. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the reception hall.
