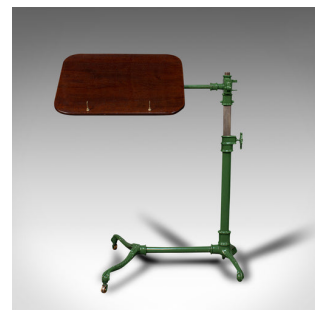


Antique Adjustable Reading Stand, English, Mahogany, Music Lectern, Edwardian

- Shaped handle to side stand releasing the height adjustment pillar
- Standing upon detailed ball and claw feet, with a pair of brass castors to one end
