- Tiered crown moulding stands prominently above the whole
- Cabinet door with four field panels, arranged with cockbeaded borders
- Dressed with an untested, inset lock key absent
- \bullet Suite of 12 drawers arranged in singles and pairs, each finished with a small brass pull
