This is a large antique master cabinet maker's chest. An English, pine and mahogany craftsman's tool trunk, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Of superb proportion and craftsmanship
- Displays a desirable aged patina throughout
- Ebonised pine presents a pleasingly dark appearance
- The mahogany fitted interior provides a shock of rich caramel contrast
- The stout lid opens smoothly with a metal cup handle to the centre
- Dressed with a small inset lock untested as key absent
- Reverse of lid finished with super mahogany stocks showing fine grain interest
- Fully-fitted interior a practical treat for the eyes
- Arranged as a trio of compartments, the uppermost lifts upon brass butterfly hinges
- Attractive decoration with a marquetry inlay of contrasting triangles
- Fully removable, the interior offers generous storage space
