This is an antique elbow chair. An English, mahogany carver with drop-in seat, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Serpentine elegance as to be expected from the Regency period
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Delightful mahogany frame shows deep russet hues and fine grain interest
- Light golden in colour, the silk cotton seat cushion displays some light marks
- Prominent top rail with concave form and wonderful figuring
- Lower back splat with carved foliate panel between scrolled leaf detail
- Striking arms with sinuous scrolled forms present beautifully
- The comfortable drop-in seat affords itself to easy professional reupholstery to taste
- Attractive reeded front legs taper pleasingly towards tall cylindrical spade feet
- Gently splayed, the rear legs terminate in square section form
