DESCRIPTION

This is an antique clerk's desk. An English, walnut pedestal writing table, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1880.

- Classic pedestal desk, pleasingly appointed
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select walnut shows fine grain interest
- Rich caramel hues beam beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Arranged as a suite of nine drawers with two pairs of eight framing one to centre
 - Finished with a traditionally ebonised top, contrasting superbly with the natural walnut stocks
- Deep, tiered edge creates a strong horizontal effect, the motif continued upon the drawer fronts
- Each drawer dressed with brass drop handles over batwing shaped back plates
- Wide central drawer replete with inset brass-lined lock – key absent
- Benefiting from mahogany lined drawer boxes with stout fronts
- Standing upon continuous plinth bases to each pedestal with tiered edges
