- Superb grain interest and medullary rays beneath a wax polish finish
- Shaped back stand with inset bevelled mirror showing a desirable light foxing
- \bullet Serpentine fall front finished with carved foliate beading and an inset lock key absent
- Supported by a hinged arm, the front opens to offer a generously sized desk
- Document boxes help arrange the interior over a central drawer, dressed with a small brass pull
- Wide drawer to lower fascia with distinctive vine-shaped brass handles
- Elegantly shaped lower apron with rolled edge and accentuated to centre with leaf forms
- Raised upon a quartet of dashing cabriole legs, slender of form and terminating in pad feet
