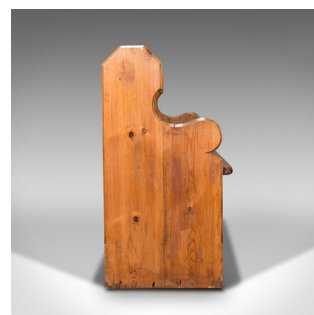


Antique Bench Seat, English, Pine, Pew, Ecclesiastic Taste, Victorian, C.1900
