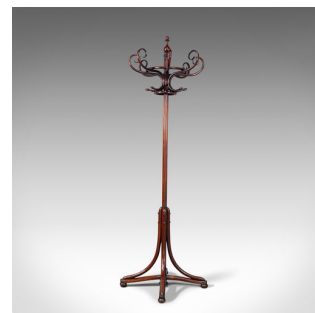
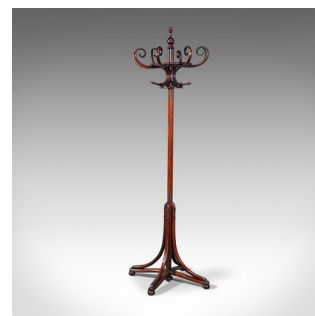
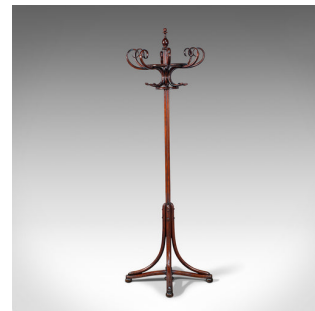


Antique Bentwood Coat Stand, English, Hallway Rack, After Thonet, Edwardian
