Our Stock # LFA-1367 This is an antique set of six mahogany dining chairs dating to the William IV era c.1835. Well made and generously proportioned, this set of chairs offer a comfortable seat on robust and stable frames joined in mahogany with wonderful hues and good graining. The triple turned front legs are complimented by swept sabre rear legs, the rails rising sinuously into the typical 'buckle' backs, united with a shaped rear back rest carved with a stylised central rosette mounted in 'C' scrolls. The drop in seats are cosseted by the side rails and located onto a peg in the front rail. Traditionally stuffed, the seat pads are currently upholstered in an unassuming, classically striped quality fabric but could be easily recovered to suit any decor. A super set of chairs with a fine finish, solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
