This is an antique conductor's stand. An English, mahogany adjustable music rest or lectern, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Slender proportion aids discretion and ease of moving
- Wide, low profile top with music rest to centre
- Folding upon two axis, with adjustable stepped rests to rear

- Boxwood stringing to each surface adds a contrasting touch
- Square front apron with triangular brackets meet shaped shoulders
- Standing upon slender turned legs with long trestle feet to either side
