- Single draw tube extends smoothly, focused by knurled wheel moving an internal rack and pinion
  - Maker's mark engraved to the trailing edge of the primary tube
  - Attaches to the elegant tripod with two brass turn screws and rotates fore and aft
  - Standing steadfast upon a trio of slipper feet
