This is a small antique sewing table. An English, mahogany bureau or correspondence desk, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Rich caramel hues beam beneath a wax polish finish
- Arranged as a pair of drawers, lined with tactile emerald green baize
 - Drawer fronts dressed with circular brass pulls and inset, brass lined locks – key absent
- Ebonised stringing to fascia and drawer edges provides appealing contrast
- Raised upon four elegant tapering legs with square toes

This is a delightful antique sewing table, versatile for use throughout the home. Superb colour and stocks, with an endearing smaller proportion. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready to enjoy.
