This is a tall antique bookcase cabinet. An English, mahogany and Bird's Eye Maple display cabinet, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Wonderful proportion, with versatility for any room or entrance hall
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select stocks show fine grain interest and rich russet hues
- Contrasting ebonised detail and Bird's Eye Maple add further appeal
- Prominent crown moulding with deep fascia stands above the whole
- The door dressed with a small brass twist latch, inset, working lock to side – key present

- Cabinet door presents a dome-top display window with a quality lower mirror
- Arranged with four removable shelves to the interior, showing bright biscuit hues
- Attractive cabinet base with rolled edge, and an inset drawer with blind pull
- Field panels with ebonised detail decorate the pair of cabinet doors – working lock, key present

- Opening to present a removable slide tray with generous space beneath
- The whole standing upon a continuous plinth foot
