



Victorian Negretti & Zambra Telescope, c.1880



DESCRIPTION

Our Stock # LFA-1377This is an antique, Victorian marine telescope dating to c.1880.The tapered brass tube is covered in dark, hard grained Morocco leather in good order. The single draw tube is dent free and inscribed 'Negretti & D'Neill'. The optics are in good order offering a clear, crisp image with an inch and three quarter objective glass. The lens cover is present as is the swivel cover in the flared eye cup. The draw tube slides very easily. Models such as this were referred to as 'Royal Mail' telescopes but were largely employed by the navies (see below).
